

New fire danger label on children's nightwear

From 1 April 2009, most children's nightwear and some daywear must have a new, orange fire danger label. The label alerts you to buy snug-fitting garments to reduce the risk of catching fire.

Until 1 July 2009, some garments will have an orange fire danger sticker instead of a sewn-in label. The sticker replaces many of the low fire danger labels, but not all. The old label has been removed or erased from the garment.

Remove the sticker before washing.

To reduce the fire risk:

- **always keep children a metre away from the heater**
- **use snug-fitting nightwear**
- **remember no nightwear is heat or flame resistant.**
